

## The DigiPen WASL Scholarship Application

For the 2008-2009 school year, DigiPen Institute of Technology is offering scholarships to Washington high school students who obtain all of the following scores on the Washington Assessment of Student Learning (WASL) tests:

1. Level 4 in Math
2. Minimum Level 3 in Science and Reading
3. A "Yes" for both the Writing and Listening components

The scholarships will cover 20 percent of total tuition costs at DigiPen for a four-year program. A maximum of 15 scholarships will be available this year. This scholarship is on a first come first served basis.

### Eligibility Rules:

- Students must be accepted and enrolled for admission to DigiPen to qualify for the scholarship.
- Students must be entering their first year at DigiPen.
- Students may only submit results of the WASL, which they obtained in grades 10, 11, or 12.
- Students must abide by the rules of the Scholarship program and maintain a specific level of academic performance in order to remain eligible for the scholarship in subsequent years.
- Students must have an accumulative 3.50 G.P.A. upon high school graduation.
- Scholarship available to graduating seniors only.
- If WASL approved students are not eligible for other in-house scholarships including Careers That Work, Imagine American or MAP.
- Student must maintain a 3.00 while attending DigiPen
- Student must maintain a full-time course load (12 credits or more). Students in their final semester who do not require 12 credits to graduate will be exempted from this requirement.
- Pass all attempted classes.
- Students must not be in violation of any of DigiPen's Rules and Regulations.
- For summer semester students can use this scholarship so long as they continue to maintain the 3.0 GPA requirements. There is no credit load minimum for the summer semester.
