# WE'VE GOT YOU COVERED



Whether you're already in Washington or coming to DigiPen from outside the region, you might be wondering about what to do for living arrangements. We can help!



DigiPen Housing provides a comfortable and welcoming living environment for you and your peers, and it's a great option if you're living away from home for the first time. We handle the lease and utilities so that you can focus on your studies, and our DigiPen Housing staff is on hand to help and support you as you adjust to college life.

How does it work? As a DigiPen Housing resident, we'll match you with a small group of roommates and set you up in a nearby apartment residence that is fully furnished and supported by a full-time resident assistant. You'll be close to campus, with free shuttle service that can get you back and forth in the mornings, evenings, or in-between. Additionally, you and your roommates will have full access to all of the on-site amenities of the apartment complex where you reside.

Going with DigiPen Housing is not a requirement, but it's an option that comes with several benefits, including:

- Fully furnished bedrooms, living room, dining room, and full-size kitchen with dishwasher and in-unit washer/dryer.
- Convenient lease terms of eight months.
- Shuttle service between apartment complexes and campus.
- A single bill each semester that includes all housing-related expenses (except cable).
- Roommate matching, mediation, and conflict resolution services.
- Monthly events and activities hosted by DigiPen Housing RAs.

# FINANCING YOUR EDUCATION

Let's find the best financial aid package for you!

If you need help with funding your DigiPen education, our Office of Financial Aid is ready to assist you in all stages of the process. Our office can help you with the following:

- How to complete your Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).
- Finding and applying for grants and scholarships.
- Financial literacy and college budgeting help for students.
- Information about other ways to fund your education, such as loans, state aid, veteran benefits, and 529 plans.

The first step in beginning the financial aid process is to submit your Free Application for Federal Student Aid online at [fafsa.gov](https://fafsa.gov). Due to pending federal changes, the FAFSA for the 2024-25 academic year will be made available in December 2023. DigiPen's Office of Financial Aid is available to help with any FAFSA-related questions.

Now is also a great time to start looking for scholarship opportunities. DigiPen offers incoming and continuing student scholarships, and outside scholarships are also available for those who apply.



## TYPES OF FINANCIAL AID

DigiPen offers several types of financial assistance to eligible students, including the following:

### GRANTS

Grants are a form of gift aid with funding from state or federal sources.

### SCHOLARSHIPS

DigiPen and other outside institutions offer scholarships based on merit, financial need, and academic success. Students are automatically considered for DigiPen merit and need-based scholarships. Scholarships based on other qualifications such as diversity, WANIC participation, and specific majors are available with additional applications.

### WASHINGTON STATE AID

State-funded grants and scholarships are available to residents of Washington.

### VETERANS BENEFITS

Veterans, enlisted military personnel, and dependents of veterans may qualify for financial aid from the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs.

### LOANS

Loans can be provided by either federal or private sources. Federal loans come from the Direct Loan Program, available to students and parents of dependent students. Private loans are offered by private lenders and should be considered only after exhausting all other sources of funding.

NOTE: Financial aid is available to those who qualify.



# WHAT'S NEXT?



We are so excited for you to begin your education at DigiPen! To summarize, here's what you can do in preparation.

**1 ENROLL** Now that you've been accepted, there are still a few next steps you'll need to take care of to finalize your enrollment.

- Say YES to DigiPen**  
From your online application status portal, fill out your Decision Reply Form to let us know you're on board.
- Complete your online learning self check**  
Next, complete the Online Learning Readiness Self-Check, also available through the application portal.
- Sign your Student Enrollment Agreement**  
At this point, you should receive an email with your enrollment agreement, which includes program details and a tuition payment schedule.
- Pay your \$150 enrollment fee, either by:**
  - Online credit card payment via the application portal **OR**
  - By mail with check payable to DigiPen:

- Send us your final transcripts**  
Ask your school to send your final transcripts to DigiPen prior to New Student Orientation — preferably sooner! Final transcripts are those that show all of your completed coursework with grades. For graduating students, the final transcripts will also indicate the date of your graduation from high school or when your degree was conferred. *(For international students, some additional steps may be required. Please check with the Office of Admissions for more details.)*

## 2 APPLY FOR FINANCIAL AID

If you plan on seeking financial assistance, now is a good time to take care of some essential steps.

### ○ Submit the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) online

Once the FAFSA is available, go to [fafsa.gov](https://fafsa.gov) and submit your application. This will be used as the basis for determining your financial aid eligibility.

The FAFSA for 2024-25 will be made available in December 2023.

### ○ Research and apply for scholarships

DigiPen scholarship applications will open December 1, 2023. You can find information about our scholarships at: [digipen.edu/scholarships](https://digipen.edu/scholarships)

As an accepted student, you can also search for outside scholarships using the Scholarship Manager online service. Log in with your DigiPen credentials (you should receive an email with your credentials shortly after acceptance) at: [digipen.edu/scholarship-manager](https://digipen.edu/scholarship-manager)

### ○ Review your cost of attendance

To get a better picture of your out-of-pocket costs, we recommend using our Net Price Calculator, which provides an estimate of your expected cost of attendance and potential eligibility for federal, state, and institutional financial aid. Go to: [digipen.edu/npc](https://digipen.edu/npc)

## 3 FIND HOUSING

It's also a good time to start thinking about your living arrangements.

### ○ Research Your Housing Options

If you're looking for a hassle-free solution, be sure to apply for DigiPen Housing. We'll set you up in a nearby apartment complex, where you'll live alongside a small cluster of fellow students and a full-time Resident Assistant.
