

Course Equivalency Guide – Washington Community and Technical Colleges to DigiPen Institute of Technology

Washington community and technical colleges have adopted a common course numbering (CCN) system for selected courses, indicated by an “&” symbol in the course code. CCN courses represent equivalent courses offered at multiple institutions across Washington state.

The following table lists CCN course equivalencies for transfer to DigiPen Institute of Technology. Transfer equivalency is subject to change. To be considered for transfer, courses must appear on an official transcript with a grade of B- or better and must have been taken within the last 10 years. Waived Courses

Students who complete a minimum of 90 college-level quarter credits with a cumulative GPA of 2.0 or higher prior to attending DigiPen may waive COL 101 to be replaced with 1 semester credit of open electives.

Bachelor of Science in Computer Engineering: Students who successfully transfer courses equivalent to 28 semester credits at DigiPen when entering the BSCE program may replace ECE 110 with 3 semester credits of STEM electives.
