## YOUR DIGIPEN STUDENT ACCOUNT

Your student account gives you access to a range of computer and IT resources, including:

- Your DigiPen student email
- On-campus computer workstations
- Colleague Self-Service
- CampusGroups
- Scholarship Manager
- Online coursework tools (such as Moodle)

You should have received your student account login credentials via email within a week of your admission. If you did not receive this email, or if you need it to be re-sent, please contact the Office of Admissions at *admissions@digipen.edu*.

Keep your student account login information safe and secure. You will use this account throughout your entire time at DigiPen.

#### HOW TO SET UP YOUR EMAIL

Using your student account credentials, you can now access your DigiPen email by going to: **webmail.digipen.edu** 

You can access your email directly from your browser using RoundCube, or you can follow the instructions for setting up an email client, such as Thunderbird.

## COLLEAGUE SELF-SERVICE

Colleague Self-Service is the online service you will use during your time at DigiPen to update your contact information, register for classes, and manage other important academic information. You can log in using your DigiPen student account username and password.

#### REGISTERING FOR CLASSES

#### For Undergraduate Students (Bachelor's Degree Programs)

If you're an incoming freshman or transfer student, you do not need to register for your first semester of classes. After you have signed your Student Enrollment Agreement and paid your enrollment fee, the Office of the Registrar will create your Fall 2025 class schedule for you, based on your degree program. We do this as a courtesy to ensure you are registered for all first-semester course requirements, as well as to ease the stress that comes with the new college experience.

Once we have created your pre-registered class schedule, you will still be able to make changes via Colleague Self-Service up to the final add/drop deadlines.

If you have any questions or concerns about your pre-registered schedule, we strongly recommend you contact your Student Success Advisor (*studentsuccess@digipen.edu*) for initial advising.

## YOUR STUDENT ID BADGE

DigiPen's campus remains locked throughout the day. To gain entry, you'll need your student ID badge, which unlocks approved exterior and interior doors around the building.

#### UPLOAD A PHOTO FOR YOUR STUDENT ID BADGE:

Please follow these instructions on how to take and upload your own ID badge photo, which will be used for the duration of your time at DigiPen.

You must upload a photo for your student ID badge **no later than August 1**. We will have your student ID badge ready and waiting for you at New Student Orientation. Photos uploaded after this date may not be processed in time for Orientation.

#### How to upload your student ID badge photo

- 1. Take a passport-format photo of yourself (i.e., vertically oriented, facing forward, and containing your head and shoulders) in front of a white background.
- 2. Log in to the application status page at: connect.digipen.edu/apply
- 3. On your checklist, click the "Student ID Badge Photo Submission" form. This will take you to a form with instructions and a photo upload option. Upload your photo as a JPEG (.jpg) file. Image size must be at least 600-by-800 pixels and no bigger than 768-by-1024 pixels.

We know you're a creative and unique person, but your student ID badge is not the place to express your individuality — it's just to get you in the building.

Please do not submit a photo containing any of the following: props, costumes, inappropriate poses, hats, background drawings/text, or sunglasses.

### REQUIRED SUPPLIES



#### LAPTOP REQUIREMENT

All new, incoming students are required to provide their own laptop computers. Additionally, some degree programs may require the purchase of additional software. #### **ART MATERIALS**

Each art course lists its required materials in the Required Materials list each semester. For BFA in Digital Art and Animation students, the Dragon Shop campus store sells a variety of arts supplies you can purchase for class. #### SOUND DESIGN TECH BUNDLE

Students entering the BA in Music and Sound Design program will be required to purchase certain sound design equipment prior to the beginning of their first semester. ## YOUR HIGH SCHOOL, COLLEGE, OR MILITARY TRANSCRIPT

If you recently graduated from high school or college, ask your school to send us your final transcript. This version of your transcript should list your date of graduation or conferment of degree. Similarly, if you have completed any college or military education courses since you submitted your application to DigiPen, please send us official transcripts for that coursework. All transcripts should be delivered through a verified electronic transcript delivery service such as Parchment, eSCRIP, National Student Clearinghouse, or SCOIR. You can also have your transcripts mailed in a sealed envelope directly from the high school or college to the address below. The last day for DigiPen to receive your final transcripts is August 18.

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### **FERPA**

The Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA) is a federal law that protects your education records. Once you start college or reach 18 years of age, your parents no longer have an automatic right to access your records without your consent. This includes information such as your grades, class schedules, tuition, and Financial Aid information. In order to designate who may have access to your records, you need to create a proxy via the Proxy Module found in Colleague Self-Service.

Under FERPA, some student information such as name and dates of attendance are considered public or Directory Information. According to the FERPA guidelines, DigiPen may release this information to any third-party that inquires. If you do not want DigiPen to release this information, you can enact a "FERPA Block" through Colleague Self-Service (CSS) via the link found in the Proxy Module.

#### **DISABILITY SUPPORT SERVICES**

DigiPen Institute of Technology is committed to providing equal access to all of its programs, courses, activities, events, and services. As required by the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990 as amended, as well as Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973 (P.L. 93-112) as amended (P.L. 93-16), DigiPen will provide reasonable accommodations to qualified students with disabilities.

DigiPen's Disability Support Services Office (DSS Office) and its staff are appointed by the president of DigiPen to review student documentation and determine the needs for any reasonable accommodations to be provided by DigiPen to ensure equal access. Wherever possible, reasonable accommodations will be offered — provided they neither fundamentally alter the nature of the programs or the academic requirements that are considered essential to the program of study, nor create an undue hardship for DigiPen. The DSS Office will also work with departments, faculty, and staff in the broader DigiPen community to prevent and eradicate discrimination on the basis of disability.

A student requesting accommodation must inform the DSS Office of the existence of a disability and assist the Office in determining appropriate and helpful accommodations and auxiliary aids. They must be prepared to provide documentation of their disabilities to the DSS Office and complete an intake appointment.

# TRANSPORTATION AND PARKING INFORMATION

Parking at DigiPen's campus is abundant but can fill up during busy hours. Students in DigiPen Housing are encouraged to take the DigiPen shuttle to campus. Students may park in any parking spot labeled with a "dP" or any other blank parking spot.

Students must register their vehicle to park on campus. To register your vehicle, go to our student store, the Dragon Shop, within the first two weeks of classes to fill out a form and receive your parking sticker.

DigiPen supports alternate modes of transportation by providing ample outdoor bike and scooter racks on campus. Bikes and scooters are not allowed indoors. Please exercise caution when biking or scooting to campus and remember to always wear a helmet.

## DIGIPEN HOUSING AND RESIDENCE LIFE

DigiPen Housing and Residence Life offers off-campus, apartment-style housing to a limited number of students based on application priority. Housing is not guaranteed for all applicants, and applicants may be placed on a waitlist if all available spaces are filled.

To ensure students can focus on their studies and make connections with their peers, DigiPen Housing and Residence Life provides the following services and benefits:

- Furnished apartments with kitchen and in-unit washer and dryer
- 24/7 on-call emergency support
- Assigned resident assistants
- Gender-inclusive housing options
- · Walking distance to campus, eateries, and downtown Redmond
- Shuttle service to and from campus and apartment communities
- Monthly community engagement opportunities

#### **OUR PROGRAMS FOR 2025-2026**

#### Academic Year Housing (fall and spring semesters)

 Academic Year Housing is offered as an eight-month contract, spanning from August to April (covers all times classes are in session, as well as holiday breaks).
 Application opens November each year.

#### Spring Start Housing (spring semester only)

• Spring-Start Housing is offered to new and continuing students as a four-month contract. Application opens in October each year.

Payment is due in full at the beginning of each term and is collected by the DigiPen Accounting Department. For the 2025-2026 academic year, the cost is billed in two parts, once in August and once in December.




## ARE YOU A PARENT OR FAMILY MEMBER OF A DIGIPEN STUDENT?


#### APPLICATION STATUS PAGE
